He published his personal reminiscences of Henry Irving in 1906 after Irving's death which proved successful and managed productions at the Prince of Wales Theatre before writing *Dracula*. Stoker met Árpád Székely, a Hungarian Jewish writer and traveller born in Szentgyörgy Kingdom of Hungary (now Svätý Jur Slovakia). *Dracula* likely emerged from Székely's dark stories of the Carpathian Mountains. Stoker then spent several years researching Central and East European folklore and mythological stories of vampires.
